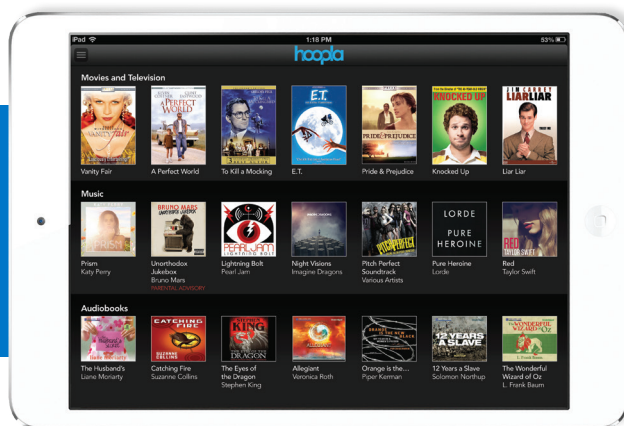

Place holds on books and media items using our online catalog system or by phone when you call (812) 944-8464. To access our catalog, visit www.floydlibrary.org and click on "My Account". You will need your Library Card number and Library PIN (automatically set to the last 4 digits of the phone number you listed when signing up for a card) to log in and place holds. When placing a hold, select your pick-up location. You will receive a notification when your holds are ready to pick up. When you arrive at the Curbside Pick-Up zone, call (812) 949-4422 (New Albany Central) or (812) 850-0094 (Galena Digital Library) to let our staff know that you are ready for pick-up. *Hours of operation are subject to change.
