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

September 28-Preparing Your Teen for College: Applications, Financial Aid info, and more! The application portal for CASI opened Wednesday, **July 26th, 2023** at 9:00AM EST. On behalf of IHCDA, funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) waiting list is open for **Clark**, **Floyd and Harrison County.**



The Section 8 HCV program is available to **income eligible** individuals and families and exists to assist with rent payments to provide decent, affordable, sanitary, and safe housing for persons with low incomes.

Applicants are placed on the list in order of preference points, then by date and time of application. IHCDA has preference points such as residency, person residing in an institutional setting, working families, the elderly, family member with a disability, youth exiting foster care, and child welfare involved families.

Placement on the waiting list is not a guarantee that applicants will qualify for assistance. Any preferences claimed at the time of application will be verified at the time of selection from the waiting list. The Section 8 HCV program is not emergency housing assistance and your waiting time for assistance may exceed 24 months.

CASI will accept applications online only at the following website: <u>Clark County</u>, <u>Floyd County</u>, <u>Harrison</u> <u>County</u>. SEJ is a CEP grant funded school that provides free breakfast and lunch to all students that are enrolled. There is no need to send lunch money to school with your child however, if you would like to put money into your child's account for additional snacks, water, milk, etc. you must use this new meal payment vendor.
