Penguins Swim Team FLOYD COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

The Penguins Swim Team, member of the Kentucky-Indiana YMCA
Swim Association (KIYSA), is a youth competitive swim team.

Participants ages 4-18 will have the opportunity to build competitive swimming skills, learn the rules of competitive swimming and increase swimming endurance. Participants will practice two or three times a week. Competitions include five dual or tri-meets and a championship meet for the full season. Participants will also receive a team t-shirt and swim cap. Team suits can be purchased separately. **All swim team members must also be YMCA facility members.**

LEVEL EVALUATION

A level evaluation will take place Thursday, August 24 from 5:00-6:00 p.m. Swimmers will use this time to demonstrate their swimming capability. Swimmers will be asked to complete a minimum of a continuous 25 yard swim of freestyle and backstroke. Swimmers will get Level feedback at the end of the evaluation. After August 24, an evaluation can be scheduled with a coach at the Floyd County YMCA.

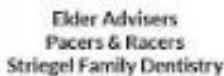

The application portal for CASI opened Wednesday, **July 26th, 2023** at 9:00AM EST. On behalf of IHCD, funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) waiting list is open for **Clark, Floyd and Harrison County.**

The Section 8 HCV program is available to **income eligible** individuals and families and exists to assist with rent payments to provide decent, affordable, sanitary, and safe housing for persons with low incomes.

Applicants are placed on the list in order of preference points, then by date and time of application. IHCD has preference points such as residency, person residing in an institutional setting, working families, the elderly, family member with a disability, youth exiting foster care, and child welfare involved families.

Placement on the waiting list is not a guarantee that applicants will qualify for assistance. Any preferences claimed at the time of application will be verified at the time of selection from the waiting list. The Section 8 HCV program is not emergency housing assistance and your waiting time for assistance may exceed 24 months.

CASI will accept applications online only at the following website: **[Clark County](#), [Floyd County](#), [Harrison County](#)**.

SEJ is a CEP grant funded school that provides free breakfast and lunch to all students that are enrolled. There is no need to send lunch money to school with your child however, if you would like to put money into your child's account for additional snacks, water, milk, etc. you must use this new meal payment vendor. Please see below.
